ABOUT PAYMENT

We participate in and accept payment from almost all insurance plans. We are happy to bill your insurance company if the service provided is covered by your particular insurance plan. Please realize routine debridement or treatment of corns and calluses or trimming of nails is not covered by most insurance plans. Exceptions may include Diabetes with vascular disease or any patient with complications secondary to vascular disease. If the service provided is not covered by your insurance, payment is requested at the time of service.

ABOUT DR. ROSENTHAL

Dr. Rosenthal is a Doctor of Podiatric Medicine. He attended Temple University receiving a degree in Pharmacy and then attended the Illinois College of Podiatric Medicine now known as the Scholl College of Podiatric Medicine.

Dr. Rosenthal finished a two-year residency in foot surgery in Chicago and became Board Certified in Foot and Ankle Surgery. He is a Fellow of the American College of Foot and Ankle Surgeons and a member of the American Public Health Association.

Drs. Rosenthal and Small and their staff wish you a pleasant welcome to our office. We understand the nervousness associated with your first visit to our office and will do our best to make you feel comfortable and relaxed.

Comprehensive Foot Care Associates is a full service podiatric care office. Conditions treated at our office include corns, calluses, ingrown nails, mycotic nails, athlete's feet, bunions, hammer toes, and all major foot disorders.

Drs. Rosenthal and Small treat all family foot problems including injuries, ankle sprains, as well as foot and ankle fractures.

Foot deformities such as bunions, hammer toes, ingrown nails and others are treated conservatively and surgically in both the office and the hospital.

Diabetic foot care is provided including treatments of ulcers and foot infections.

Warts are also commonly seen and treated at our office.

Orthotic devices (specialized foot supports) are casted for and supplied by our office with corrections made for flat feet, high arch feet, and walking abnormalities in children. These are also used for heel spurs and many other foot deformities.

Modern modalities include x-rays, injections, hydrotherapy by a whirlpool, ultrasound as well as electrocautery. Drs. Rosenthal and Small are also certified in laser treatment.

He is a staff member at most of the area hospitals and is an adjunct clinical professor at the Pennsylvania College of Podiatric Medicine.

Dr. Rosenthal has published papers in Podiatric Medicine and has been involved in educating Podiatric surgical residents.

Currently he is Chief of the Podiatric Medicine Department at Episcopal Hospital in Philadelphia, a teaching hospital associated with the Temple University Health Systems.

ABOUT DR. SMALL

Dr. Small is a Doctor of Podiatric Medicine. After graduating from the Pennsylvania College of Podiatric Medicine in 1987, he completed a two-year podiatric surgical residency in Mt. Clemens, Michigan. He is Board Certified in foot surgery by the American Board of Podiatric Surgery.

Dr. Small is on staff at several area hospitals and surgical centers as well, where he lectures and participates in residency training.
